Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As you are aware the Premier has announced a statewide lockdown in South Australia for the next 6 days.

For the next two days – 19 and 20 November 2020 – St Aloysius College will be closed except for the care of the children of essential workers. These are school closure days and, as such, no online learning will be provided.

We will have a small number of staff on site to provide supervised care to any family who requires this essential service.

If your daughter will be present on either of these days:

- ensure you have informed us of her attendance via the SMS line 0438 433 333
- please enter via the Wakefield Street entrance so that we can register your daughter's attendance at the front office
- provide a packed recess and lunch, and a water bottle, as the canteen will not be available
- students may wear their PE uniform on these days
- students will be dismissed at 3:15pm from the front office (unless they are booked into OSHC)
- OSHC service will be available, bookings are essential


The school will remain closed in the week commencing 23 November except for the care of children of essential workers. Students have been asked to bring home all the materials and equipment that will assist them to learn from home next week.

Remote learning materials will be provided via SEQTA, Microsoft Teams and email as appropriate to individual year levels and subjects.

The remaining scheduled Year 10 and Year 11 examinations will not proceed. Students may be provided with exam papers for some subjects as a learning opportunity. These will not be officially assessed or included in the end of term report.

We remain hopeful that we may be able to gather again before the school year ends. As always, we appreciate the strong partnership that has helped us to navigate these uncertain times.
