The Catholic Archdiocese of Adelaide / Diocese of Port Pirie takes its duty of care seriously for those who entrust themselves to it and to ensure the health, safety and welfare of all participants in programs and activities. It recognises and encourages the significant role that the Church and school communities play in the provision of an environment that nurtures the wellbeing of children, young people and those who are vulnerable.

Accordingly, we are required to fulfil all legal requirements set out under the Child Safety (Prohibited Persons) Act 2016, together with the requirements outlined in the Catholic Archdiocese of Adelaide/ Diocese of Port Pirie, Screening Policy.

To maintain the highest standards of child protection St Aloysius College is required to:

1. Receive from all third-party providers the names and details of all participants who will be working with children during the prescribed activity; plus
2. Receive documentation from external (off-site) third party provider, to confirm that all personnel involved in the provision of services to children have been screened in accordance with the requirements of the Child Safety (Prohibited Persons) Act 2016 and all Government directives and Catholic Education South Australia policies relating to the protection of children.

This information must be obtained prior to the planned lessons taking place and will be considered current for one year or will be valid for 12 months.
