

DAME ROMA MITCHELL JUSTICE SCHOLARSHIPS YEAR 7, 2022

Information Sheet

In recognition of Dame Roma Mitchell's outstanding contribution to the promotion of a more just society, and to acknowledge her appointment as Governor of South Australia, the St Aloysius College Board decided to honour this eminent old scholar by initiating the annual award of a number of Justice Scholarships.

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of the following criteria:

- students entering Year 7 in 2022
- will take into account the financial circumstances of the family
- are awarded to students showing potential in academic studies, Art, Music or Drama

The scholarships provide 100% remission of tuition fees from Years 7 to 12. They are offered to students who would not otherwise be able to attend St Aloysius College to undertake their secondary education.

The following fees and charges *will be* payable by the scholarship recipient:

- Non refundable \$50.00 enrolment fee
- Student service fee
- Text book loan fee
- Charges for camps, retreats and incidental items such as ID card and damage to or non-return of library or hire books.
- Stationery items, books and uniforms
- Laptop service fee (Year 3 to 12 students) and any excess charges if lost or damaged

The process for awarding scholarships is as follows:

- Applications must be received by **4pm on Friday 30 April 2021**
- A shortlist of students to be interviewed is determined by the Principal
- Students to be interviewed will be contacted to attend an interview
- Students selected for an interview will be requested to bring a folio of their work to that interview

Following this process, the scholarship recipients will be determined and notified. The decision by the Principal is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
