SACRAMENTS OF CONFIRMATION & FIRST EUCHARIST

Students from Year 4 who are of the Roman Catholic Rite and have already celebrated the Sacrament of Reconciliation are now able to prepare and celebrate the Sacraments of Confirmation & First Eucharist to complete their Sacraments of Initiation. The celebration of both these sacraments will occur on Wednesday June 22 in the St Francis Xavier Cathedral.

A meeting on **Tuesday April 5 at 7pm** in the **Redden Undercroft**. Please enter via Angas Street gate. At this point, expected COVID-19 restrictions would include mask wearing. Should other restrictions occur, you will be notified.

- Prior to the meeting, consideration needs to be given to selecting a suitable sponsor for your daughter.
- The sponsor must be a fully initiated Catholic having received Baptism, Confirmation & First Eucharist, over the age of 16 years and a good role-model. The sponsor should also be someone your daughter knows. Often a godparent is selected.
- Please note that you as a parent cannot be the sponsor as you already have a special role in your daughter's faith.

Further information regarding preparations will be discussed at the meeting.
