

Year 12 Mid-Year Examinations

Year 12 students are preparing to sit their mid-year examinations, with the main examination week being Week 10, Term 2, from **Monday 4 July to Friday 8 July**. **Friday 1 July will be a swotvac day and students will not be required to attend school.**

During the examination period, students are expected to attend each of their scheduled examinations but are not required at school at other times unless subjects without an examination have a scheduled session during the examination week. Individual subject teachers will inform the students of any arrangements.

All exams run for 130 minutes unless specifically stated otherwise on the exam schedule below.
