^{*}Warranties and insurance cover the laptops against accidental damage and theft. Due to the high cost of the device, a maximum excess of \$375 per claim will be invoiced to families for any accidental damage or loss. Similarly, accidental damage or loss to accessories issued with the laptop will incur a maximum excess of \$50 per claim. The laptops can connect wirelessly to the College network and can be taken home at the end of the day. Student laptops are kept in service for three years upon which time students will be issued with a new laptop. Families leaving the College have the option to buy their laptop for a residual value of: \$1350 - 1 year old, \$675 - 2 years old and \$150 - 3 years old. The College uses returned devices as loan devices to assist in keeping fees affordable. The IT team will assess laptops that are returned to SAC damaged and a charge may be passed on to the family.

DISCOUNTS

St Aloysius College is pleased to offer the following discounts to eligible families:

Siblings*

10% discount on Tuition Fee for each child when more than one child from a family is enrolled at St Aloysius College.

Early Payment*

5% discount
on Tuition Fee offered when families
have no outstanding fees from the
previous year and all fees are paid in
full by the end of February.

School Card

Minimum 50% discount on Tuition Fee subject to eligibility. This rate is reviewed after meeting with the Business Manager.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE - Families with Financial Difficulties and School Card Scheme

Direct Debit Payment Plan where a set amount is deducted from a nominated bank account or credit card on a regular basis, with full settlement by the end of the school year. (Please complete a Direct Debit Payment Plan Form)

Option B

Payment in full by the last day of February. An early payment discount of 5% on tuition fees applies.

Option C

Three equal payments due on the final day of February, May and August.

PENALTIES

- 1. St Aloysius College relies on prompt payment of all fees to manage its own cash flow. In the event that an account falls into arrears and no genuine attempt is made by the family to arrange a mutually satisfactory payment plan with the Business Manager, St Aloysius College will forward the account to a Debt Collection Agent. All costs associated with this action will be borne by the family.
- 2. A charge is made for damage to, or the non-return of library books.
- 3. Damage or loss of laptops will incur a maximum excess charge of \$375 per claim.
